Speaker Mr. Mike Rumsey



We are privileged to have a speaker at our Meeting. Mike Rumsey, the Curator of Minerals at the Natural History Museum - London (formerly, The British Museum) since 2003. Prior to this, he was the Mineralogical Curator at the Oxford University Museum. At the Natural History Museum, Mike's responsibilities include the maintenance, documentation and management of the museum's 14,000+ minerals. This collection is recognized worldwide as one of the finest collections in the world.

Rumseyite, $[\text{Pb}_2\text{O}]\text{FCl}$, is named in honor of Mike Rumsey, who discovered the mineral. It is the first naturally occurring fluoroxychloride mineral which is associated with calcite, cerussite, diaboite, and hydrocerussite. It was found in a small cavity in 'hydrocerussite' from a manganese pod at Merehead quarry, Somerset, England.
