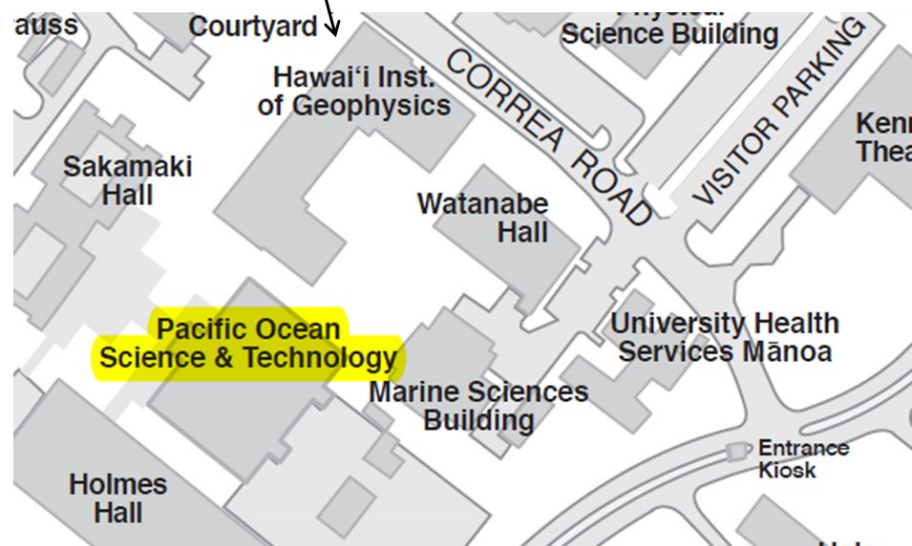
This month's meeting will be on Friday , August 26th at 6:15 pm.
